


READ SCRIPTURE OR BE A GREETER

A FINANCE MINUTE

What is Wesley's Horizon Fund?

In 1999, the congregation of Wesley United Church established the Horizon Fund to maintain the momentum of financial donations which were formerly for payment of the mortgage.

The purpose of the Horizon Fund is to provide financial access for large projects deemed worthy and not possible within the parameters of the Local Ministry Budget. These may include

new initiatives or projects, new equipment, large non-recurring repairs or any other special endeavors.

In 2008 Church Council approved the following Motion: "A repair or replacement of an essential object, structure or equipment, costing more than \$500 shall be eligible for emergency funding from the Horizon Fund". In 2013 Church Council approved a motion "That all elevator related expenses would be paid from the Horizon Fund." Any Horizon Fund Surplus money is transferred to a Tangerine Bank account to earn interest.

Through a motion of Church Council, a minimum of \$5,000 must remain in the Horizon Fund for emergencies.

Examples of Horizon Fund projects over the years; initiation of Youth Ministry program, new heating and air conditioning for the Sanctuary and Robbins Hall, new roof for Sanctuary & Robbins Hall, new fire alarm panel, computer upgrades, buy a chair and table projects, audiovisual upgrades, new electronic outside sign, lettering on the outside wall of the Sanctuary.

To the end of September, the Horizon Fund had income of \$3,941 and expenses of \$11,026 in 2024, leaving it with an overall bank balance of \$17,276.
